Grades

Advanced Level Grades

A pass in an Advanced level subject is indicated by one of the five Grades A, B, C, D, E, of which Grade A is the highest and Grade E is the lowest.

Grade N indicates that the candidate's performance fell short of the standard required for Grade E by a narrow margin.

The grades for the Special Paper are Grade 1 (Distinction) and Grade 2 (Merit).

Advanced Supplementary Grades

A pass in an Advanced Supplementary subject is indicated by one of the five Grades A, B, C, D, E, of which Grade A is the highest and Grade E is the lowest.

Grade N indicates that the candidate's performance fell short of the standard required for Grade E by a narrow margin.

Examinations in AS subjects are of the same standard as examinations in Advanced level subjects, but AS syllabuses cover about half the subject content of Advanced level syllabuses.
