Grades and Symbols

Definitions of Grades

The results of the GCSE examinations are reported on an 8-point scale of Grades: A*(a*), A(a), B(b), C(c), D(d), E(e), F(f) and G(g). Candidates who fail to reach the minimum standard for G receive no grade and a subject receiving no grade is not recorded on the certificate.

Double Awards in Science

The results in these syllabuses are reported on the 8-point scale and the grade is recorded twice on the certificate to indicate that the results in these syllabuses have the same status as GCSE grades in two other single-certification subjects.

Explanation of Symbols
