Functions & controls

Please familiarize yourself with the parts and accessories listed below



Battery installation

- 1. The battery compartment is located on the back of the clock. Unlock the battery compartment and take cover off.
- 2. Insert three **"AAA"** size batteries (not included), and aligning the polarity indications (+/-) as shown in the diagram below:



3. Reinstall the battery cover.

Note: Remove the batteries if you do not use the product for a long time

Time and Date Setting

- 1. Press and hold the **'SET'** Button for three seconds to enter clock Setting
- The display will start blinking, you can press 'UP' or 'DOWN' to select 12Hour Mode or 24Hour Mode. Once your desired mode selected, press 'SET' once.
- Next, the Hours will start to blink on the display, 'UP' or 'DOWN' to select the current Hours, and press 'SET' once.
- Next, the Minutes will start to blink on the display, press 'UP' or 'DOWN' to select the

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current Minutes, and press 'SET' once.

- Next, the year will start to blink on the display, press 'UP' or 'DOWN' to select the year, and press 'SET' once.
- Next, the month will start to blink on the display, press 'UP' or 'DOWN' to select the current month, and press 'SET' once.
- Next, the date will start to blink on the display, press 'UP' or 'DOWN' to select the date, and press 'SET' once.
- 8. Now the time set is finished, the display will display the time you just set.

Setting the Alarms

- 1. Press and hold the 'ALM-SET' button for three seconds to enter Alarm Setting.
- 2. On the display, the hour will starting blinking.
- 3. Press 'UP' or 'DOWN' to select the desired hour to be set, and press 'ALM-SET'.
- 4. The minutes will start blinking
- 5. Press 'UP' or 'DOWN' to select the desire minstes to be set, and press **'ALM-SET'**.
- 6. Now the display will resume back on current time.
- 7. Please make sure you have activated the Alarm if u want it to ring.

Turning On Alarms

- To enable / activate an alarm, you can press the 'ALM-SET' button on the back of the alarm clock
- 2. Once you enter the Alarm setting, you can press the **'UP'** button to enable / activate the alarm.
- 3. The bell icon also appears when the alarm is enable / activated.
- 4. When the Alarm is RINGING, you can press 'UP' or 'DOWN' once to turn OFF the Alarm.

Turning off Alarms

- 1. To disable an alarm, you can press the **'ALM-SET'** button on the back of the alarm clock.
- Once you enter the Alarm setting, you can press the 'UP' button to deactivate the alarm.

3. The bell icon also disappears when the alarm is deactivated.

Backlight and Snooze Setting

 When the alarm is active you can press the 'SNOOZE/LIGHT' button on top of the alarm clock to stop the alarm, a snooze function is activated for 5 mins.
 IF you want to turn off the Alarm, press 'UP'

or 'DOWN' once.

2. The snooze button also acts as the backlight. Press the snooze button to activate the backlight on the display. The light will remain on for about **5** seconds and turn off automatically.



Temperature Display

 The temperature display can be displayed in Celsius and in Fahrenheit. Press the 'DOWN' button to select either Celsius or Fahrenheit.

- 3. Do not mix normal and rechargeable batteries together.
- 4. Only use '1.5V AAA' batteries.
- 5. If display seem faint please replace the batteries.
