Insure your trip for less

Bets Buy insurance for travellers of all ages – plus how to get the cover you need for the cheapest price possible

fter the summer we've endured this year, many of you may already be thinking of booking your next holiday.

With the credit squeeze on, you may decide to look for potential savings by booking a shorter break, a UK holiday or waiting for a last-minute bargain.

But you can also make surprisingly large savings by making sure you get the best bargain travel insurance.

Do you need insurance?

In some cases, for example if you're holidaying in the UK, you may not need travel insurance. Home insurance will cover many personal items for loss or damage (if you have the right cover), the NHS will cover health, and car insurance will take care of transport, if you drive.

Cutting the cost

Travel insurance certainly is essential when you go abroad, but shop around for the best deals. We found huge differences between like-for-like policies.

A 50-year-old looking for a single-trip policy covering four days in New York could cost from £10 with Best Buy OUL Direct to £55 with Age Concern.

SAVING The £45 that you save may even be enough to buy a silver pendant from Tiffany & Co in New York.



Gone skiing

If you're planning a daring activity on holiday, make sure you tell your insurer when getting a quote.

If you buy the wrong policy, any claim made could be rejected. Most insurers will have specialist policies, for example covering winter sports. We found impressive savings on these policies, too.

A 25-year-old on a five-day skiing holiday in the Pyrenees, for example, would pay £8 for a single-trip policy with OUL Direct. Halifax charges £49.

SAVING The £41 saved could pay for a decent pair of ski goggles and gloves.

Travelling light

You may be able to tailor Best Buy quotes to your needs and get an even better deal. If you travel light and don't intend to buy expensive gifts while abroad, or if you got a cheap deal on your flight or holiday, it may be worth waiving baggage and/or cancellation cover on the policy.

ZOOM AND BUST

What protection do you have if the airline you're travelling with goes bust?

When XL (one of our worst airlines in five different categories for customer service in our survey (*Which?*, July 08, p40) Zoom and Silverjet collapsed this year, thousands of holidaymakers were stranded. This was because their travel policies didn't include Scheduled Airline Failure Insurance, which ensures another carrier will get you home or to your destination if your airline goes bust. Some insurers, such as Swiftcover.com, offer this for an extra premium, but it's usually sold separately. We recommend you pay by credit card so you qualify for a refund under the Consumer Credit Act. If you've bought a package holiday, check whether your provider is covered by the Air Travel Organisers' Licensing scheme. This offers alternative flights and refunds if an affiliated airline goes bust. For more details, see p78.



For instance, you could get a discount of up to 20% if you exclude cover for baggage on a single trip policy from OUL Direct – an option if you travel light.

Waiving cancellation cover could be worth considering if you're just hopping over the Channel, for instance.

Insurewithease.com gives a 20% discount if you opt out of cancellation cover on a single-trip deal. This could be a choice if you get a cheap last-minute deal to a resort on the Costa Brava.

Waiving cancellation cover is less likely to appeal on more expensive trips, given the cost of flights and accommodation in many far-flung destinations.
