

The perfect mix

We've whipped, chopped, grated and mixed our way through a food mountain to bring you 15 Best Buys

Even those of us who love cooking would surely like to spend less time on tedious tasks such as chopping and mixing. A hand blender, hand mixer or food processor can tackle these jobs much more quickly than you could by hand and produce more even results.

However, before you rush out to buy the latest model together with tons of attachments, think about what jobs you'll use it for.

One of our Best Buy food processors with a liquidiser would be great if you're a busy cook or catering for a large family. But

even aspiring Jamie Olivers may not often use all its features.

A hand mixer might be your thing if you're making cakes, pastries and light doughs as well as whisking and whipping. A Best Buy blender will be fine for puréeing baby food, blending soup, and whipping up shakes and smoothies.

Of course, if you have only the occasional vegetable to slice, a set of kitchen knives may be all you need.

There is also quite a range of attachments available for many machines. See 'Choosing the tool for the job', p49, for more on this.

How we test



We check how well the food processors make juice

Food for thought

Our experts tend to put on weight during this test. They spend many hours putting the blenders, mixers and food processors through their paces and once the tests are finished, they use up the food rather than throw it all out. Food that is suitable goes to an animal shelter near our lab, while employees eat some of the rest.

During testing, we whisk 170 egg whites and whip eight litres of cream; bake 28 cakes and 26 loaves of bread; chop 5.8kg of hazelnuts, 580g parsley and coriander, and 29 onions; grate 2.2kg of cheese and carrots; slice 2.8kg of cucumber and purée 10.8kg of meat and veg.

We rate how well the machines fluff up egg whites and cream, whether cakes and breads rise properly and whether mayonnaise is stiff enough. We also check how many lumps are left in the purée by passing it through a sieve. Machines are scored on how evenly and finely they chop foods, and the consistency of milkshakes and fruit smoothies. We also note how much food gets stuck to the side of the bowl when grating and slicing.

Finding the right model for you

Buying tips on choosing a machine that does what you want it to

■ BLENDER EXTRAS

Hand blenders (see p46) increasingly come with a range of attachments. A £25 pack for the Dualit (10) has a chopping container, blending beaker, balloon whisk and beaters.

■ FAMILY MATTERS

We test a wide range of machines but there are others which differ from tested models only in colour and attachments. We expect such 'family models' to perform similarly. The Braun MR 6550 MCA hand blender (2) and the MR 6500 M are the same apart from the attachments they have. The Kenwood Wizzard Pro HB615 (3) has a

measuring beaker with lid, the HB665 has a chopper and whisk, and the HB655 has these plus a plastic rod and lower wattage. The Kenwood HM320 hand mixer (2), p48, also comes in chrome (HM326) and matt silver (HM327). The Kitchen Aid 5KFP770 food processor (2), p49, comes in five colours, shown by letters after the product number.

■ OTHER NAMES

You may see models under different names. The Kenwood Wizzard Pro blender, (3), p46, is on Next's website, as 'Kenwood hand blender'. The Breville SHM2 hand mixer (1),

p48, is in the Argos catalogue as 'Breville twin motor hand and stand mixer.' Some manufacturers' websites show you where to buy. Good shops to try are Comet, Currys, Debenhams, John Lewis and Robert Dyas.



Hand blenders

These are easy to use, cheap (from about £8) and need little space. They are most suitable for blending and puréeing, but can be versatile. Those that have whisk or grinder attachments will do much more and may save you splashing out on a food processor. Grinders and choppers have different capabilities, though – for example, some are suitable for coffee beans. You can also use these blenders to make hot soups and sauces in a pan. Our Best Buys are excellent at chopping small items, such as herbs, but some models struggle even with this, and hand blenders in general are slower at liquidising than jug blenders. Choosing a blender with a detachable rod, dishwasher safe if possible, will make cleaning quick and easy. The

rods on the Kenwood (4), the Bamix (6), and the Hinari (12) cannot be removed.

On the subject of cleaning, covered switches (such as those pictured, left), mean no dirt traps. The Braun Best Buys (1 and 2), the Breville (8) and Philips (9) all have them.

The Braun MR 4050 HC can handle all blending, puréeing and chopping tasks

This quiet model is light and comfortable to use, and can handle all blending, puréeing and chopping tasks. It's excellent at whipping cream, makes lovely mayonnaise and chops nuts and herbs quickly and evenly. The main shaft can be detached for easier cleaning. You can buy it at Argos and John Lewis.

WE FOUND It comes with a measuring beaker, whisk, chopper and wall-storage holder.

You get separate whisking and chopping attachments and a measuring beaker with this Braun. It performs most tasks well, though it's not as good at whisking egg whites as the Krups Best Buy. The rod and attachments (except the whisk gearbox) are dishwasher safe. It's available at Argos, Comet, Currys and John Lewis.

WE LIKE This is particularly sturdy and the accessories are solid, too.

Hard to handle

This Breville is the heaviest hand blender on test, weighing in at more than 1kg. It's also long, so it's less easy to manoeuvre.

Out of steam

Most of the tested models completed the 150 cycles of our durability test quite happily, but the Hinari gave up after 12 cycles.

What you see is what you get with this light, comfortable and basic blender. It has just one speed and there are no extra attachments. However, it chops evenly, makes smooth purée and shakes, and excellent mayonnaise and smoothies. It's easy to store and comes with a plastic measuring beaker. It's available at Robert Dyas.

WE LIKE The HB150 is the quietest of all the Best Buy hand blenders.

It's one of the quickest hand blenders at whisking egg whites, producing really good results in less than four minutes. It's brilliant at chopping herbs, too, and is the only hand blender with a digital display, so you can easily choose the speed you want. It's available online.

WE FOUND It's the slowest at making mayonnaise but results are excellent.

Hand mixers

Hand mixers take the effort out of whisking, whipping and cake mixing and are perfect for keen bakers. All tested models are good or excellent at whipping and mixing, though food processors were better at kneading heavy doughs.

The Antony Worrall Thompson model (10) was the most disappointing. It scored just one star out of five for durability – all other models were five-star performers. We tried three samples of the mixer and all stopped working barely a fifth of the

way into the test. Mixers are easy to store and clean. The Breville (1) and Wahl (8) come with stands you can rest them on while they're working. However, jobs take longer using the stand and it's less convenient than using the mixer handheld.

This excellent mixer has five speed settings and high and low power buttons. It's slower using the supplied stand, taking ten minutes to whisk egg whites compared with two when handheld. It's easy to set up and comes with dough hooks and two sets of beaters, all dishwasher safe. You can buy it at Argos, Currys and John Lewis. **WE LIKE** It was the fastest hand mixer at making stiff and even mayonnaise.

The compact Kenwood is easy to set up, fits comfortably in the hand and mixed our cake to a lovely consistency in just over a minute. The cable and attachments clip to the machine, making it easier to store. Its metal beaters and dough hooks are dishwasher safe. You can buy it at Debenhams and John Lewis. **WE FOUND** It's impossible to insert the dough hooks incorrectly.

Food processors

If you want to mix dough, or slice, chop or grate family-sized portions of vegetables, a food processor is a good investment. It's faster and more effective at kneading dough than a hand mixer and often produces more consistent results than a hand blender when chopping nuts, herbs and onions. Of the models with jug blenders, all were impressive at liquidising purées, shakes, smoothies and mayonnaise. Some struggle with grating and whisking, though, and they can be a pain to store. What they can do depends on what accessories they're supplied with. A machine with a large feeder tube, such as the Kitchen Aid (2), will take larger items, such as potatoes, without you having to slice them first.

Other features worth having include a pulse setting that will allow you to process in short bursts for more control. The processor stops as soon as you release the button – great for jobs that need a light touch.

Choosing the tool for the job

All you need to make juice, grind coffee or blend soup

Food preparation machines, especially processors, often come with attachments. Here are some common choices.

■ CITRUS PRESS

A cone and sieve for juicing oranges, lemons, grapefruits and limes. To juice hard fruits or veg, choose a centrifugal juicer attachment.

■ **DOUGH HOOKS** You usually get these with hand mixers and they're used for

kneading yeasted food such as breads.

The dough blades that you get on processors tend to be more effective.

■ **KNIFE BLADE** As well as chopping, this can be used for mixing, mincing, mashing and puréeing.

■ MAXI-BLEND CANOPY

This large disc can be used with the knife blade to blend soups more effectively.

■ **MILL** For making small amounts of purée, grinding coffee beans and spices, and

chopping nuts and herbs.

■ **MINI BOWL** A small bowl with its own blade which fits inside the main bowl. It's useful when you want to process only a small amount of food, such as nuts. Chopping is slower because the blade is shorter, which makes it less effective at circulating food.

■ **WHISK** This comes in various guises: you might get an emulsifying disc or a whisk paddle, but twin beaters are the most effective.

The quiet Magimix is slower than its sister model, the Compact 3100 (1), but it is great for chopping, grating and

slicing in particular. It has the same whisk paddle as the Compact, a citrus press and mini bowl. The touch controls are easy to use and to wipe clean. You can buy it online.

It does everything that a processor should, but takes up much less space than other models do.

This Bush and the Breville FP13 rock when kneading heavy dough. This can unlock the lid, which switches the appliance off.

Speedy grating and slicing are among the strengths of this model, which comes with the usual attachments. The whisk paddle is slow at whipping cream and the bread we made rose less than that from other models.

However, herbs are chopped evenly and finely in seconds. You get mini and midi bowls as well as the main bowl. It's quiet, easy to clean and won't wobble about on the worktop. It's available at John Lewis.

WE FOUND The mini bowl isn't as good at chopping herbs and onions as the main processor.

The idea of Click and Go is that you fix the lid and bowl in any position and remove the lid at the click of a button. The processor and jug are great at a wide range of tasks. It's simple to use and there aren't too many accessories. It's noisy but well built and durable. It's available online.
