There aren't enough owners in our survey for full details, but the S40/V40 is a double award winner – as the safest and most secure large car we've tested. Running costs are low, but Volvo's brand reliability is poor.

OWNERS' VERDICTS

There were too few questionnaire replies for the S40/V40 to feature in our survey.
