A poor combination

If you're after a TV with a built-in DVD player, a conventional set has the best picture and sound

If you're short of space – say, in the kitchen or a child's bedroom – and want to avoid a confusion of wires, a combination TV and DVD player sounds ideal. However, none of the TVs tested is truly widescreen, so digital pictures may look squashed or stretched. And none of them has a digital tuner, so when the analogue signal starts being switched off in 2008 they'll become obsolete.

Our tests also show that you may end up compromising on the quality of picture and sound. Overall, the six small TVs with built-in DVD players that we tested were disappointing

What you should look for

RESUME

Resume means the DVD player will start the disc where you stopped it (instead of at the beginning each time) – though you usually have to leave the disc in and the player on standby. Models with multi-disc resume remember where to start playing the disc even after you've removed it and reinserted it

DISCS

Not all DVD discs are the same. All DVD players will play pre-recorded DVDs (those you rent or buy). But if you record your own there are several different formats -DVD-R, DVD+R, DVD-RW, DVD+RW and DVD Ram. None of the players we tested plays back DVD Ram discs. However, they can all play standard CDs and discs containing Jpeg picture files, so you can show your holiday snaps on your TV screen, for example

REGIONS

A DVD is coded according to the region in which it will be sold and distributed. The combi TVs we tested play back DVDs from

region 2 (western Europe). However, we found that the Goodmans (5) played back discs from region 1 (US) despite not claiming to do so



Don't Buy



None of the LCD combis on test is worth buying, but the picture and sound on the Bush LCD15DVD013 (6) are particularly poor, especially on the DVD player.



especially on the DVD player. It's also tricky to use. Inserting a DVD is confusing because you have to put the disc in with the label facing away from you, and the remote control is cluttered, with lots of buttons and tiny writing. The DVD player also lacks useful features, such as bookmarking and resume.
