# **Tackling the block**

### New technology makes short work of blocked pipes – but old favourites can be effective, too

For many years, the trusty plunger and potent caustic soda have been the main solutions to a blocked plughole. But nowadays there's an array of alternatives to choose from. Brightly coloured cocktails of bleaches and acids come as liquid, foamers (granules or gel that foam when you add water) or powder. And technological 'super plungers' claim to clear stubborn blockages with minimal hassle and time.

We put these new products to the test against more traditional methods. The result? Caustic soda is more effective than most new-fangled cocktails. In fact, three chemical solutions - Domestos 15 Minute Sink & Pipe Unblocker (17), Cillit Bang Universal Stain & Drain (18) and Buster Bathroom Drain Clear (19) - are less effective than a kettle of hot water. But there is some progress: the power plungers beat everything hands down.

# **Now we test**

We bung up the plughole of our testing sink with 14g of hair, soap, toothpaste and cotton fibres or 18g of fat and food debris, and add 100ml of water. We then time how long it takes to clear the blockage with each product.

Our sink is connected to a transparent pipe, so

we can observe the reactions while measuring temperature changes. We allow each unblocker 24 hours to do its job, though most users would call a plumber much sooner. Finally, we test chemical

unblockers on materials such as laminate, stainless steel and copper to see what damage they cause.

# **Don't Buy**

Mr Muscle Kitchen Sink Unblocker (20) is supposed to effervesce in water, loosening the blockage. If it doesn't fizz enough, as happened in our tests, it coagulates to cause a worse blockage. We



cleared it with pure acid, but most people would need a plumber. We tried it several times, with varying amounts of water, but the result was the same.

The manufacturer told us:

'There may have been standing water above the blockage. In this circumstance, the crystals start to work prior to reaching the blockage, considerably weakening

the product's ability to remove blockages."

We aren't sure how you are expected to remove any standing water. If there isn't any to start with, you wouldn't know the sink was blocked.

If you decide to remove the U-bend, be careful about spilling chemicals or water when you remove the trap. Check that the reassembled joints are sealed properly.
