# **Remarkable remotes**

All-in-one remote controls could provide welcome relief from the jumble of controllers littering living rooms, but which ones push our buttons?

For many people, having a gaggle of remote controls scattered around the living room is a familiar story. Each works with a single device, demands its own diet of batteries, and often goes into hiding just when you need it the most.

Enter the all-in-one remote control. These do-it-all saviours are a solution to the rising number of remotes we use with set-top boxes, TVs and DVD players.

Your first priority when buying a universal controller should be to find out whether the new remote will work with the devices you own. Many universal remotes list brands and model codes for the devices they work with. By programming these codes into the remote, you can then use it with each device you own. While many universal remotes boast of being compatible with hundreds of brands, the reality is that only a few of these are relevant in the UK.

To help universal remotes keep up with new purchases of electronic audio and visual devices, some can download updates from the internet, receiving new codes so you can use them with new devices.

Some remotes also feature 'learning' capabilities, which mimic the functions of all your remote controls. This patiencetesting process requires you to aim an existing remote at your all-in-one replacement. As you press buttons on your old remote, followed by a button on the all-in-one remote, the device 'learns' the functions of your old controllers.

Certain remotes are more complicated than others, while others have greater functionality. Touchscreen remotes, for example, display only the buttons relevant to the device you have selected.

Keep in mind that universal remotes cannot match the intuitive usability of controllers designed for specific devices. We found that a small number of the remotes we tested were incompatible with set-top boxes for Freeview digital TV, so it's best to check for this when you're buying a remote.

# How we test

To test both the versatility and compatibility of each remote, we create a list of devices, such as TVs, VCRs, and DVD players, including big-name brands, less common manufacturers and own brands available in the UK. We check that each remote is capable of advanced and basic functions. Ergonomics assessors then test each for ease of use and convenience of design.

The highest-scoring remote in our test, Philips' pricey Prestigo combines a satisfying and versatile touchscreen with a clickwheel for navigating menus, similar to the one used on the popular iPod. Up to eight devices can be programmed with ease, but, as it can't download updates, new devices will need to be controlled via the learning function.

Sleekly named and with the looks to match, the Stealth can operate five devices, and we found it easy to program. It can support up to 15 macros for creating operation shortcuts. A learning function will futureproof it to ensure compatibility with new devices. A clearly lit indicator light shows which device has been selected to control.

WORTH KNOWING Even with its batteries removed for 24 hours, the Stealth still retains all its programming.

Our tests found that inputting brand codes is straightforward, and the controller has a learning capacity that lets it mimic other remotes. A clear instruction manual and included DVD makes it easy to set up this remote.

WORTH KNOWING Unlike many other models, the Comfort Grip has no light to indicate which device you are controlling.
