Beat the heat at home this summer with one of our Best Buy air conditioners

The weather is a very British preoccupation and as the mercury rises, conversations will turn to the best ways to keep cool. But for some, keeping cool isn't a luxury – it's a necessity.

Babies sleep better in rooms no warmer than 20°C, and older people need to take care when the heat rises. As people age their bodies don't react to the heat as quickly as a younger person's – this puts them more at risk of health problems as it gets hotter. A cooling air conditioner would be a solution.

There are three main types of air conditioner.

Mono blocks Mono blocks (also known as

single units) are fairly cheap, but they didn't do as well as split models in our test. Monos are mostly portable and can be moved from room to room, providing coolness where you need it. They have a hose that needs to be vented outside – poke it through a window or drill a hole in the wall.

There are also fixed versions that are about the size of a fat radiator. They are hung up and vent through a hole in the wall. **Split units** Split-unit air conditioners are becoming more popular in homes where one room gets unbearably hot. These models are made up of two separate units connected by a pipe containing refrigerant. The slim internal cooling unit is hung inside, while the noisy fan is outside.

Central air

conditioning These control the temperature in your entire home from one dial. As there are very few on the market, we haven't tested them for this report.

Chilling cost

Air conditioners can have a significant effect on your electricity bill (see 'Cost of cool', opposite), as well as on the environment – go to www.which.co.uk/ airconditioners for more information. But if you or family members are affected by the heat, our Best Buys are efficient and great at keeping you cool.

1 SPLIT MODEL 91% LG Art Cool A09AW1 £880

The LG Art Cool is brilliant at cooling quickly and quietly. It dehumidifies well and has a heater function for yearround use. A 'chaos swing' setting mimics a natural breeze by moving the louvres (slats) so the airflow is directed

up and down. The sleep mode allows you to set a time for the air conditioner to switch off, and it also slows the fan speed – this means it runs



quieter with less screen illumination. Two further timer settings set exact on and off times when it's not in sleep mode. This wall-mounted model needs to be professionally installed by a specialist – contact LG for details.

WE LIKE This model is disguised as a framed picture. You can personalise it by sliding in your own photo or print.

Buying advice Essential air-conditioning questions answered

How can I cool my home fast?

A mono model is fairly cheap and doesn't require you to drill a hole in the wall, as the hose can be fed through an open window. However, this

> allows cooled air to leak out and warm air to creep back in. It also compromises your security.

They are quite noisy – most are as loud as a fridge on its cooling cycle – but you can cool any room you want. Some models come with a window gap accessory that minimises the amount you need to open your window. They work best with sash or sliding windows.

What if I don't want to leave a window open?

You have two options: both require drilling a hole into the outside wall.

A fixed split unit is wall mounted and takes up much less space than a single mobile model. One part of the unit is in your room; the other, noisy part is on the outside wall.

You can vent all mono blocks through a hole in the wall. There's no unit to fit on the outside wall – which makes them easier to install – and you can plug the hole in winter. The hose concertinas: make sure it's less than 1.5m from the hole, as warm air pools in a long hose and radiates heat back into the room.

Fixed models, like the Unicos (14 and 18), take up less room.

What will I need to fit a split unit?

If you're installing on the first floor or higher, use a ladder or scaffolding. An SDS drill, diamond bit corer and extension bar will enable you to bore a hole through the wall. You can rent these from a hire shop for about £30 to £40 an hour. Alternatively, use a lump hammer and brick bolster to remove a square section of brick. Fill in the resulting gaps with pieces of brick and mortar.

Check your model comes with a three-pin plug – if it needs to be wired in you will have to consult an electrician. And if personally bashing holes in your home doesn't sound ideal, get an expert in.





2 SPLIT MODEL **87%** Amcor HW-12EZ £600

The fixed, wall-hung Amcor is great at cooling and dehumidifying. This highend model has lots of modes that you can set to your own personal taste. These include a sleep mode that helps vou to nod off at night – lights dim on the main unit and the fan slows to reduce noise. The fan can be activated

to swing up and down as well as from left to right, allowing you to direct the cooling breeze in different

directions. The airflow strength is also adjustable. And condensed water from the dehumidifier is automatically piped outside, so you don't have to drain it away.

WATCH OUT It can be used as a heater, but only if the outside temperature is above 10°C.

7 MONO MODEL 83% DeLonghi **Pinguino PAC** W 130A £690

This is the only mobile air conditioner we tested that you add water to

- this enhances cooling ability and reduces noise. However, water tanks need regular filling and have to be descaled when put away for winter. You can fill the tank directly from the tap by using either the handy extendable hose or the jug provided. It is highly effective at cooling and dehumidifying. As the model is guite heavy, you will want to confine it to one floor rather than trying to carry it up and down stairs

WORTH KNOWING If you don't add water, this model isn't as efficient.

COST OF COOL

The scoop on energy ratings

The average air conditioner uses enough energy in a day to power a fridge for a week. Every model is rated A to D for energy efficiency by the manufacturer, except the DeLonghi (7). But the current system allows a 12 to 15 per cent margin of accuracy. We see this as misleading.

Ignore the energy ratings and look at our costs in the table, p66. The worst offender is the Wickes (12). It costs 37p to run for three hours - almost double the 19p cost of the Prem-i-air (3). Fans cost about 1p a day to run and use a fraction of the power of air conditioners, but they only move the air around – they don't cool it.

8 MONO MODEL 75% Issimo **9 HE** £549

The Issimo is very mobile. It's light enough to carry up and down stairs and has a good, grippable handle



behind the control panel. A large rear wheel helps with manoeuvrability and a retractable fabric lead makes it easy to pull along on flat surfaces - this makes the small and squat Issimo look like a dog on a lead when you tow it between rooms. This model has many different functions, including dehumidification, varying fan speeds and night modes that reduce noise. You can also set the start and stop times.

WORTH KNOWING The £450 Best Buy 8 HE version scored 81% in a previous test (see www.which.co.uk/ airconditioners) and is still available.

This cheap but **DICEPTIONAL** basic model is **VALUE**

exclusive to Wickes, and it cools fast and dehumidifies really well. There is no

remote control or night mode, but it does have a countdown timer which can be set to between one and 12 hours, so rooms can be cooled before you need them. The slats have to be moved manually to change the direction of the fairly moderate airflow. **WORTH KNOWING The bung on the** water pipe is tricky to release.

10 MONO MODEL 71% DeLonghi NF 170 £200

This is the cheapest DeLonghi we tested, and it can quickly cool and dehumidify. It has no night mode, but you can set its delay timer to automatically turn off to avoid wasting energy while you sleep. Three fan speeds can be used separately from the air conditioner to freshen up the room, and it has a dehumidification setting. WATCH OUT As this is our noisiest Best Buy, you may want to avoid installing it in a bedroom.

For those without this feature, the measurement is taken while in cooling mode – all air conditioners dehumidify automatically. **Noise** Subjective rating based on low/night and high-speed settings. Even machines with five stars are noticeably audible. **Ease of use** How easy it is to install, set up, maintain, operate and program.
