Light fantastic

Getting glasses really clean can be difficult. After the dishwasher finishes its drying cycle, traces of magnesium and calcium from the water can leave a film on glasses.

This can often be removed through rinsing or wiping with a cloth. If it is not removed after the first wash, further washes can lead to more build-up, which is more difficult to shift.

To check how well the tablets prevent this filming, we put glasses through ten continuous wash cycles and then place them on a light box to see how clear they are. The best results on test were with the Finish Powerball Classic and Fairy Powder Bursts.

Finish sparkles

Our test of 16 dishwasher-detergent tablets reveals the best

More and more homeowners in Britain own dishwashers, and last year, for the first time, we spent more on dishwasher detergent than on washing-up liquid.

But if you are thinking of chucking out the cleaning brush and joining the machine age, which detergent works best?

Your choice is between a separate detergent – together with rinse aid and dishwasher salt – or a combination product such as a 3-, 4- or 5-in-1. We tested six detergent-only and ten combination tablets.

The big winner was Finish, which came top for both separate and combination products. Its Finish Powerball Classic got the best results and was cheaper per wash than our other Best Buys.

It's a detergent only, so you'll also need to buy rinse aid and dishwasher salt. This adds about 3p to the cost of a wash, but even then, it's our cheapest Best Buy.

In most cases, you're better off buying the biggest pack available, (provided that you can carry it home), as larger sizes will work out cheaper per tablet. A word of warning, though. If you choose all-in-one tablets, check your dishwasher manual first. If you have an older machine that doesn't have a 3-in-1 button and isn't designed to work with all-in-one products, you may invalidate your warranty. In this case, choose one of our Best Buy separate detergents.

With all-in-one tablets it's best to add dishwasher salt in hardwater areas. Sainsbury's 3-in-1 and Asda 5-in-1 Citrus tablets fail to mention this. See 'Adding salt', below, for more.

Jargon buster

There are plenty of choices on the market but what do the different available options mean?

■ SEPARATES These are detergent-only tablets so if you use them, you will also need to buy rinse aid and dishwasher salt to add to your wash. We tested all the detergent-only tablets in this way with the dishwasher on a normal program setting.

Combination products/ all-in-ones

3-IN-1 These contain detergent, rinse aid and a salt function. We tested all

these on a 3-in-1 program without adding rinse aid or dishwasher salt.

■ 4-IN-1 Like 3-in-1, but with an ingredient which claims to keep glasses looking newer for longer.

5-IN-1 As with 4-in-1, plus an ingredient that claims to give a better shine to stainless steel.

The fourth and fifth components vary from one brand to the next so check packs for details.

Adding salt

Most combination tablets include a salt function which softens water in the wash, helping to leave glasses streak free. But your machine may suffer if vou don't add separate dishwasher salt, as Brian Collin discovered. Brian used 3-in-1 tablets which cleaned well but after about 18 months his machine's heating element stopped working and had to be replaced. Brian's fitter told him that the 3-in-1 tablets hadn't replenished the model's softener unit in the way separate dishwasher

salt would. Deposits built up, damaging the element and costing £100 to repair.

Many all-in-one tablet packages warn that you should use extra dishwasher salt in hard-water areas and it is advisable to use a little regularly to keep your machine working well.

Facts & scores

Some facts we found during testing

Last orders

Morrisons will soon replace its own-brand Cyclon 4-in-1 with a newer formulation so it may not be in shops much longer.

Detergent only

If you buy separate tablets, you need to add rinse aid and dishwasher salt to your wash. All separate products mentioned this on their packaging apart from the Asda Smart Price and Tesco Dishwasher Tablets.

Don't buy

We rate Waitrose Dishwasher tablets as a Don't Buy because of their poor cleaning ability.

ON TEST DISHWASHER DETERGENT



80% Finish Powerball Classic



This detergent-only tablet cleaned impressively. It removed baked-on milk, the toughest stain on test.

Most tablet types left glasses free of watermarks but none matched the high shine and minimal clouding that the Finish Powerball Classic achieved. It's available at Asda, Morrisons, Sainsbury's, Tesco and Waitrose.

WE FOUND The largest pack size we found in shops was 66 tablets but Finish says it also makes packs of 100.

79% Finish 5-in-1 Powerball

20p per wash The 5-in-1 cleaned well

across the board. It left no watermarks – a result helped by the extra 20 minutes' drying time given by the 3-in-1 setting on our dishwasher. As with all other tablets on test, glasses were cloudier after ten washes than with Best Buy separates. It's available at Asda, Morrisons, Sainsbury's, Tesco and Waitrose.

WE LIKE It gave the best results on egg, a test all-in-ones mostly tackled better.

Tablet type All-in-one Pack sizes 15, 30, 45, 60

The Fairy Powder Bursts left traces of tea on cups but cleaned milk effectively



77% Fairy Service Fairy Powder Bursts 20p per wash

BEST BUY

Once removed from the pack, these detergent-only tablets need no unwrapping. The outer layer dissolves in the wash to release the detergent. They left traces of tea on cups but cleaned milk effectively and left little clouding on glasses. At 17p a tablet they're the most expensive separate tablets on test. Add about 3p for dishwasher salt and rinse aid, and the cost is similar to Best Buy Finish 5in-1. It's available at Morrisons and Tesco. **WE LIKE Its packaging is recyclable.**

USING THE TABLE

Cost per pack The lowest high-street price of the largest widely available pack. Pack size The largest size that is widely available.

Specification

Cost per wash The average cost of a tablet calculated from price and largest pack size. For detergent-only tablets this includes 3p for rinse aid and salt.

Test performance

Rinsing Based on brilliance and how it stops watermarks on glasses after one wash. **Cloudiness** How well it stops a film building up on glasses.
