All-in-one printers

We pick the best-value printers that let you fax, scan and copy

Il-in-one printers combine a scanner, photocopier and printer in one unit. Some higher-end models will also have a fax. This can be a great way of saving money, as you won't have to fork out for three or four separate devices.

There's a bewildering array of models on the market. We've tested a range of popular makes, and our analysis revealed two Best Buys, both from Canon.

If you do decide to invest in an all-in-one printer, it's important to consider how much it will cost you in the long term. Often, the print costs aren't reflected in the initial price, as the graph, right, shows.

> The Dell AIO 948 (14) is priced at £70, but it has the most expensive running costs of the printers we tested – it will set you back £505 over three years. You'd save

£428 if you bought the Kodak ESP 3 (6) instead. It costs £80 in the shops and just £67 to run over three years.

Printing photos can also be expensive. It would cost you £2.54 to print an 8x10-inch colour photo on the Dell (14), and that's without factoring in the cost of photo paper (see Which?, April 2008, p70 for our Best Buys). But if you bought the Kodak (6) you'd be able to print a colour photo for 17p.

Finally, as all-in-ones often cost more than standalone inkjet printers, it's important to ask yourself whether you really need the extra features. If you don't think you'll use the scanner or the copier, there's no point in having them.

See Worth considering', below, for our top budget pick and a great alternative if you're only interested in printing photos. They not Best Buys, but they offer good value for money.

Running costs

What will a printer cost you in the long run?

This graph will help you compare initial purchase prices and three-year ink costs for a moderate user (someone who prints one photo, three text pages and two colour graphics pages a week) to give you an idea of how much the printer will cost over its expected lifespan. Cartridge costs vary, so our print costs should be used as a guide only.

Worth considering



Photo printer HP A526 67% £50

It isn't a Best Buy, or an all-in-one, but this budget photo printer has a lot going for it. It produces reasonable colour prints, particularly when printing directly from your computer, and good black-and-white images. A 6x4-inch photo will cost you about 32p. **WORTH KNOWING** Most good small photo printers cost around £100. You'll get 156 photos from the A526 before you've paid that much.



All-in-one printer Kodak ESP 3 60% £80

If you want a machine that's more versatile than a small photo printer, intend to print a lot of photos and don't want to pay the earth, then pick up a Kodak ESP 3 (6). Although it isn't a Best Buy, the initial purchase price is low, it produces good-quality images for just 17p (excluding paper) and has low costs for other types of printing. **WORTH KNOWING** You can't print photos directly from memory cards.





76% Canon Pixma MX850 £250

This Canon Pixma is our top-scoring Best Buy, thanks to a great performance when printing both text and photos. Photographs scan well and at

good speeds. Results aren't as good when scanning documents that combine both text and images, but are still acceptable. Although the MX850 is quite expensive, running costs are low. The printer takes up quite a lot of desktop space, so make sure you've got room for it.

71% Canon Pixma MX7600 £350

The Pixma MX7600 produces excellent text documents and good photos at impressive speeds, and it's easy to use. Scanning is better on this device than on the cheaper MX850. But, like its sibling, it has a duplexing function, which means you can print doublesided documents automatically. Although it's slightly more

expensive to run than the MX850, it's a lot cheaper than other models we've tested.

WE FOUND The sealer cartridge that treats plain paper before printing improves the quality of documents.
