Let's get ready to tumble

In this report we help you to get the most out of your dryer and find a Best Buy to suit your needs

Nearly half of UK households own a tumble dryer, but only a tiny fraction of those will have heard of a gas-powered model, let alone have bought one.

Of the 21 tumble dryers on test, we found 11 Best Buys. As well as conventional electric models, there are, for the first time, two gas tumble dryers. And with saving money in mind, an electric-vented Best Buy is available for as little as £160.

But before you buy, be sure to factor in the cost of energy consumption, which can add up with regular use. Electric tumble dryers use about 0.6kWh of electricity per kilo of clothes dried. For a 7kg load this works out to about 52p a load, or £95 a year when tumble-drying every other day.

Gas tumble dryers are substantially cheaper to run than their electric counterparts. If you dry a 7kg load in either of the Best Buys, the mains gas required will cost about 21p a load, or £38 a year. IT'S A GAS

You might think your tumble dryer options are limited to electric models, but you'd be wrong

Gas-powered vented machines are available from White Knight. The two we tested did very well in our tests and are significantly cheaper to run than electric models.

Gas tumble dryers work in the same way as vented electric machines – air is heated and passed through the load to dry the clothes. Moist warm air is then vented through a hose taking the heat and moisture away. But gas tumble dryers use mains gas to heat the air inside the dryer. Electricity is used to turn the drum and power the control panel, but this is less than 10% of that used by an electric dryer.

You can buy a gas tumble dryer directly from White Knight, but you'll



also find them on the high street and online.

Once you've bought your tumble dryer, it will need to be professionally installed and regularly serviced by a Corgi-registered engineer. To find one, call 0800 915 0485 or visit www.trustcorgi.com

Gas dryers don't have EU energy labels, but they are endorsed by the Energy Saving Trust.

WHICH? FAMILY TAKES A TUMBLE

To save money and energy, Darren and Toni Jones replaced their inefficient old tumble dryer with a new A-rated machine from John Lewis in March this year.

The new machine can handle a larger load but only uses 2.1 kWh of electricity a load, about half of the energy of their old machine. Over a year this will save them £31.

'We like the sensor, as it means we're not wasting any energy or time getting our clothes dry,' Darren said. 'The timer means the children's school uniforms can be dried and ready at breakfast time without the need for any ironing. And we use the water collected on our plants, which now get a drink after each load.'

How good are the bestselling tumble dryers?

You'd be forgiven for thinking a bestseller has plenty to recommend it, but that's not necessarily the case. Of the top 10 bestselling tumble dryers, only two are Best Buys. So before you invest in a new machine, read our lowdown on these models. See www.which. co.uk/tumbledryers for full reviews.

61% INDESIT IS60V and INDESIT IS60VS £143 If you're looking for a cheap, basic vented tumble dryer, this model would make a good choice. The IS60VS is the silver version.

39% INDESIT IS70C and INDESIT IS70CS £179

This condenser lets far too much water escape and is one to avoid. The IS70CS is silver.

46% BEKO DRCS68W £190 High energy use

and poor drying times mean there's little to recommend this freestanding condenser.

61% BEKO DRVS62 £140 High energy use and average drying times from this vented Beko.

68% BOSCH WTE84307 and BOSCH WTE8430S £308 This B-rated Best Buy condenser is a good choice if you want to

minimise your bills. The WTE8430S is the silver version.

44% WHITE KNIGHT 38AW £108 Compact and vented with only a 3kg drum. It dries less evenly

than most models, so not a great choice unless space is tight.

55% WHITE KNIGHT 44AW £129 Below average performance for a vented machine.

Both of these Bosch condensers combine speedy and even drying with excellent ability to

collect the water from your clothes. The WTE84307 Exxcel takes almost two hours to dry a full 7kg load of cotton clothing – around 16.5 minutes a kilo. It has automatic programs for cotton, woollens and synthetics, as well as shorter quick and refresh programs. The WTE84103 Classixx has a smaller capacity at 6kg fully loaded, and takes an hour and 43 minutes to dry a full load of cottons. It has programs for synthetics and blended fabrics, and each setting has four drying options. Both are sensor dryers. They're cheapest online. **WE LIKE The WTE84307 Exxcel comes with a handy digital display on the control panel.**

Miele's T294C is one of the quietest machines we've tested and aboveaverage brand reliability makes it a worthy Best Buy. It dries clothes quickly and evenly and has a maximum capacity of 6kg. The condenser function works well, and the automatic sensor chooses the drying time for you. There are programs for denim, outdoors clothing, shirts, silks and sportswear as well as more standard programs. It's cheapest online.

WORTH KNOWING It's easy to use but the heat exchanger is quite tricky to remove and clean.

65% Bosch WTS84516 Logixx £450

This large Bosch has an 8kg drum capacity and a



basket for drying clothes that aren't suitable for tumble drying such as trainers and hand-wash woollens. The basket fits inside a fixed drum, where the heat dries the clothes rather than a traditional tumbling action. When it comes to conventional tumbling, this Bosch is quick and even, as well as quiet and very easy to use. It's cheapest online.

WE LIKE A delay timer means you can set your dryer up to 24 hours in advance.

Using your tumble dryer

Hints and tips on how to get the best out of your tumble dryer

ENERGY SAVING Reduce drying times and save energy by separating different fabrics and drying similar clothes together. This also increases the evenness of drying.

LOOSE LOADS When

you take it out of the washing machine, loosen your laundry a little. This will help to prevent lengthy drying times and reduce creasing.



DON'T SUPERSIZE Don't dry large objects, such as duvets and blankets, because there won't be enough space for air to circulate. This can overheat the dryer.



■ KEEP IT CLEAN To keep your dryer running at peak efficiency, clean the lint filter every time you use it. Heat exchangers in condenser dryers will need cleaning at least four or five times each year. If your dryer uses a sensor, wipe the dryer's drum every few months with white vinegar or stainlesssteel cleaner.

72% Bosch WTB76556 Logixx 10 New Dimension £650

This Bosch has the largest drum of any machine we tested this time. It's a sensor dryer with a massive 10kg



capacity. It dries clothes swiftly and evenly, but size-wise it's a bit of a monster all round, so it would be more at home in a utility room than a kitchen. Like the Bosch WTS84516, there's a basket for drying clothes that aren't suitable for tumbling. It's cheapest online.

WE LIKE The large door makes loading and unloading very easy.

A vented model from Miele, this tumble dryer comes with a smoothing program to help reduce the creases from a washing machine spin-cycle. There's also a program for handwash woollens.

This machine has a sensor dryer, a capacity of 6kg, and takes an hour and 28 minutes to dry a full cotton load. It dries clothes quickly, is very easy to use and comes from a brand with above-average brand reliability. It's cheapest online.

WE LIKE The lint filter is particularly easy to remove, clean and replace.

This vented model from Bosch dries swiftly and evenly. A full 7kg load of cottons will take only an hour and 55 minutes – just 16 minutes a kilo. There's a sensor to measure how dry your load is, and a light inside the drum helps with unloading. It's one of the quieter machines we've tested and is very easy to use - setting programs is straightforward, as is removing, cleaning and replacing the

16 VENTED

66% Whirlpool AWZ **3303**£160

At just £160 this vented Whirlpool represents exceptional value for money. It dries quickly and evenly and is easy to use, but there's no sensor. Instead, it works on a timer and takes an hour and 47 minutes to dry a full 6kg load of cottons. Programs are simple and there are no buzzers, indicator lights or a digital display to help you, but in our tests there were no drying weaknesses. It comes with a six-minute cold airing cycle and a 13-minute anti-crease phase when the dryer finishes. It's cheapest online.

20 & 21 GAS VENTED

71% White Knight Eco 43A £349 70% White Knight Eco 83A £369

White Knight may not have any Best Buy electric tumble dryers, but its two gaspowered machines did very well in our tests. Drying is quick and even, with the Eco 43A drying a full 7kg load of cottons in less than two hours. The Eco 83A took slightly longer in our tests at two hours and seven minutes. And running costs will be significantly cheaper than for electric machines (see 'It's a gas', p67). They're cheapest online. WORTH KNOWING A cold cycle cools your clothes after drying, or can refresh previously worn clothes.

The WTB76556's (12) 10kg drum handles the largest of family loads but the price tag won't appeal to everyone, and it's bigger than most, so you'll need to have plenty of room for it. The 7kg WTV74103 (13) is cheaper, easy to use and, with drying times of 17 minutes per kilo, is a good all-round dryer.
