# The new wave

From those that roast chickens to perfection to models that are designed for the fanciest of fitted kitchens, we test the latest microwaves that are on the market

Built-in microwaves are increasingly chosen to save space in kitchens or if style is as important as function, so we've tested them for the first time. All three of the models are Best Buys but, while they may look great in modern kitchens, built-in microwaves are pricey.

If you're after a more affordable option, vou could choose one of our Panasonic Best Buy microwaves that can be fitted into a kitchen unit using a trim kit that is sold separately.

While cooking with a microwave is still unlikely to meet Gordon Ramsay's approval, our latest test shows you can do much more than heat up uninspiring TV dinners. Modern standard solo microwaves are perfect for tasks like reheating meals and defrosting food, but combination models include convection heating and grills, so you can cook more adventurous food such as roast dinners.

Some older and disabled people find microwaves easier to cook with than standard ovens, but not all are designed with their needs in mind. So we've checked all the models' controls, displays and instructions to see how easy they are for everyone to use.



## **85%** Panasonic **NN-SD466M** £119

While it may be a little pricey for a solo standalone microwave, you get what you pay for with this Panasonic. It reheats meals guickly and evenly without drying out food and it's consistent even when reheating several items in a row. Unlike

most microwaves, it has superb auto buttons, so you can cook great pasta, curry or jacket potatoes simply by entering the weight. Although it is designed as a standalone, this model can be fitted into kitchen units using a trim kit. It's available from John Lewis. WE LIKE The controls are clear and it's easy to operate for people with visual impairments and those who have difficulty gripping.

# What you should look for

#### **OVEN AND GRILL**

Combination microwave ovens use convection heating (fanned hot air) and have grills, so you can use them to both cook and brown food



### **CRISPER PLATE**

This plate will help crisp pizza bases. You tend to get better results with frozen pizzas and by preheating the oven and plate for about five minutes before putting in the food

#### **AUTO-REHEAT BUTTONS** With these, you enter the weight of food and the microwave will calculate how long it will take to cook

We carry out many lab tests, including using probes to see how evenly the microwaves heat up meals and defrost meat.

Our testers also cook and taste food, such as jacket potatoes – it saves hours to microwave these compared with baking them in an oven. We cook the potatoes using auto buttons, then tuck in, considering ease of slicing and the

## **81% Neff H5430N0GB**£353

This chic microwave is available built in only and comes in white, black or



brushed steel. It's expensive, but it will look great in a modern kitchen. It takes a little longer than other Best Buys to heat a ready meal to a safe temperature, but it cooks evenly and consistently. The controls are a cinch to use, with large text and numbers. It's available online only. WORTH KNOWING To get the best out of your microwave, you get a free recipe book.

## 74% Bosch **HMT9626GB**£365

You'll pay top whack for this built-in solo microwave but, if you're after style as well as one that's easy to use, this may be for you. It reheats food evenly without drying it out, but when used continuously the temperature can drop.

It has easy-to-push buttons and large text and numbers. We'd recommend defrosting food manually with this

model, rather then using the auto button. It's available online only.

WE LIKE You can adjust the length of bleeps, making them easier to hear good if you're in another room.

## **3 SOLO STANDALONE**

## 79% Sanyo EM-S3577 £65

This is our cheapest Best Buy and it's another excellent all-rounder. It's good at reheating a ready meal with virtually no hot or cold spots. It also cooks consistently after using it for long periods and from one day to the next. This microwave defrosts evenly and it has simple controls. It's available online only.



WORTH KNOWING Its auto buttons don't produce good results, so it's best to adjust the time and power settings yourself.

This stylish built-in stainless steel model will slot nicely into the latest kitchen units. It's a great all-rounder, too. It reheats quickly, evenly and consistently. It doesn't have an auto-

defrost button but the manual settings defrost evenly. The controls are a doddle and it has an easy-to-open drop-

down door. It's available online only. WE LIKE This microwave has an oven and grill to rival your main oven. It cooked a crispy, golden chicken in half an hour and it grills food evenly over a large surface area.

## 4 SOLO STANDALONE 75% Panasonic **NN-T545W**£89

This white standalone model is great at reheating ready meals to a safe temperature quickly, evenly, and while shrinking food less than other models on test. It has good auto buttons for heating curry or cooking jacket potatoes, and the auto defrost is great, too. It can be fitted into kitchen units using a trim kit. It's available from Comet and John Lewis.

WE LIKE It's easy to program - a step-by-step guide is displayed on the front panel so you don't need to dig out the instruction manual.

## **11 COMBINATION STANDALONE** 75% Panasonic NN-**CT766MBPQ** £200

This is a microwave that does the simple jobs well and has the added bonus of a good oven and grill. It reheats guickly and evenly, as long as it's not used continuously, and it's simple to use. We cooked an appetising roast chicken in 40 minutes and its auto button is ideal for heating up pasta. It's available from Argos, Comet and Robert Dyas.

WORTH KNOWING Defrosting food with the auto button works much better than if you program the microwave manually.

## Don't Buy

Following our testing, we advise you against buying the Sharp R85ST (15). Results show this model struggles with simple microwave tasks like cooking a ready meal without drying



it out. It defrosts unevenly and we were unimpressed with our jacket potato when we used the auto button. And if you're planning to cook several meals one after another, each for the same length of time, the second or third meal may not be cooked properly.

## The way we were

You can reheat, grill and roast in a modern microwave, but when Which? first tested them in 1975 they were good only for 'quick snacks and defrosting and heating up food'. Back then a basic model cost £259 – more than £1,400 in today's money; you can pick up one of today's Best Buys for £65.

The Zanussi comes with a Pyrex dish and a square glass roasting dish with rails, so you can cook several things at once.

## **Microwaves for all**

### We test all models to find those that are easier for disabled and older people to use

**Overall**, our **Best Buys** are suitable for older and disabled people

All the microwaves are simple for most people to use, which we know by checking how easy it is with each to set the clock, use power and time controls, read the display, clean the microwave and follow its instructions. But some older

and disabled people have needs to help them do these everyday tasks. So we've checked how easy it is for people with visual impairments or conditions like arthritis to operate each model. Tests are based on guidance from Ricability – the Research Institute for Consumer Affairs, an independent charity that publishes information on products that are suitable for disabled people.

Microwaves that score top marks for people with visual impairments (see table below) are clearly labelled, have large text and bleep each time a button is pressed so you can count through the settings.

Those models that get five stars for people with limited use of their hands or arms have doors that

are easy to open and controls that can be pushed as well as gripped without too much force.

Overall, our Best Buys are suitable for disabled and older people. In particular, the top-scoring Panasonic solo (1) has well laid-out controls and symbols that are easy to understand.
