Budget buys near the Finish

Cheaper dishwasher tablets challenge the big boys in our test

The 'No 1 recommended' seal and the endorsement of 20 manufacturers on packs of Finish have helped to make the brand the market leader. And in our tests. Finish Ouantum is the best combination tablet - but it's also the most expensive, so it's worth checking the superb budget buys on offer. Tablets from Glist, Tesco and Lidl gave great results at a fraction of the cost of Finish.

We tested 11 combination and five detergent-only tablets. The list of claims for combination tablets grows ever longer, with the 5-in-1 actions usually comprising detergent, stainless-steel shine, glass protection, salt

action and rinse aid. They are more convenient than detergent-only, as you don't need to add rinse aid, but always read your dishwasher instruction manual for guidance on adding salt, based on the water hardness where you live.

We found that the best detergent-only tablets gave marginally better results than the best combination tablets, and generally cost less, too. Three new products from Finish and Fairy are being tested and will be covered in next month's 'First look'.

80% Finish Quantum Powerball 25p per wash

This combination tablet was very impressive at removing all types of stain, especially tea. The formulation has been updated since we last tested and the tablets have improved enough to make them a Best Buy. For added convenience, there's no need to unwrap each tablet, as the protective resin coating dissolves in the dishwasher.

80% Glist Multi **Action Magic Vinegar** 19p per wash

Glist has also put new ingredients into its tablets - in this case, in the form of traditional vinegar.

This gave fantastically sparkling glasses, and, although slightly worse than Finish on tea stains, it was one of the best



combination tablets for removing milk, starch and egg stains. And it costs a quarter less than its Best Buy rival. Available Wilkinsons Pack sizes 30



82% Lidl W5 9p per wash

It's not often we feature a Best Buy from discounter Lidl, but its own brand W5 shows just how good some products from the German supermarket chain can be. These tablets are remarkably good at cleaning, rinsing and preventing cloudiness for the price, even when the cost of separate rinse aid and salt is included.

Which tablets are the greenest?

Tough stains need tough chemicals, and most dishwasher detergents contain phosphates, bleaching agents and surfactants, which break down stains. These leave dishes sparkling, but they could also harm the environment.

We've tested three products that claim to be ecologically friendly compared with conventional products, which contain more than 30 per cent phosphates. All three are free from phosphates, petrochemicals, chlorine compounds and synthetic colours and are not tested on animals.

Ecover (14) tablets impressed us and

removed all food stains

well. Starch proved a problem for **Tesco Naturally (15)** tablets, and their ability to remove milk was only average. **Sonett (16)** tablets fared less well, failing to remove starch and egg.

If you've chosen a green tablet, using a matching rinse aid makes

sense. We tested the green tablets with the same rinse aid as the other detergent tablets, and

> also Ecover and Sonett with their own-brand rinse aids. While these may cost a bit more, they were as effective as the standard rinse aid.
