Fairy on top of the tree

Fairy is once again our top washing-up liquid, but the own brands are certainly giving it a run for its money

While we can't prove the old adage that it will make your hands as soft as your face, Fairy is still the most effective washing-up liquid we've tested. However, own brands from Marks & Spencer and Tesco are hot on its heels.

Not all big brands make it as a Best Buy. Persil Aloe Vera (6) performed poorly in our tests last year, but the company told us it was reformulating the liquid to enhance its performance. We've tested the new formulation and it performed significantly better than the old one, but it still isn't a Best Buy because it isn't that effective at cleaning greasy dishes.

Most of the products we tested offer good value for money. For example, it costs less than 10p to clean

1,000 plates with Marks & Spencer Citrus (2). Last year, we also tested some very cheap liquids from supermarket budget ranges. We haven't tested them again as we found that they offer value for money only if you are prepared to use an awful lot of liquid every time you wash up.

If you're looking for a liquid that is kind to your skin, Marks & Spencer Classic (3) and Surcare Sensitive (5) are milder and also perform well.

Unfortunately, we also found that the green brands do not work as effectively as their chemically enhanced counterparts, although they still get the job done (for more on eco-friendly alternatives, see 'How green is your liquid?', below).

How green is your liquid?

They are more pricey and less effective than the chemical brands, but green liquids are kinder to the environment

The surfactants (the materials that break through grease) in many washing-up liquids are made from oil-based petrochemical ingredients, some of which may not be easily biodegradable. As a result, residues can build up in the environment causing damage, such as pollution to aquatic life.

We tested five 'green' washing-up liquids: Bio-D, Clear Spring, Ecover, Sonett and Ultra Dishmate, which are designed to have low environmental impact. All



claim to be biodegradable and use plant-based ingredients.

Overall, these liquids didn't perform as well as the standard liquids. Some are pricey, too, but they will get the job done and are certainly worth considering for their environmental benefits. Clear Spring (16), Ecover (17) and Bio D (18) all do a

> satisfactory job. Tesco Naturally (12) also uses plant extracts to form surfactants but makes no claims about biodegradability, so we haven't included it in the green section of the table.

How we test



Machine washed

We scrubbed our way through more than 2,900 plates using a machine which mimics the action of washing plates by hand at 45°C.

Fat and food removal

To test how efficient the liquids were at removing a mixture of everyday foods, we smeared plates with a range of food residues such as pasta, meat and eggs. We then counted the number of plates cleaned before the foam disappeared. This gave us our 'foam duration' rating. To get our fat removal score, we poured on an exact amount of coloured animal fat and counted the number of plates cleaned until the fat started to settle back on to them.



82% Marks & **Spencer** Citrus 79p

This Marks & Spencer washing-up liquid isn't quite as efficient as Fairy, but it still cleaned 39 dirty plates per squirt and is excellent at degreasing fatty

plates. You should be able to



clean a very commendable 9,750 dirty plates with a single bottle. It also manages to beat

its more expensive stablemate, the Marks & Spencer Classic (see right).

We tested widely available leading brands and supermarket own labels as well as a selection of eco-friendly brands. The more stars the better.

Test performance

Foam duration Rating is based on the number of plates smeared with non-fatty food we cleaned using a set amount of liquid before the foam disappeared. A brand rated $\star \star \star \star \star$ was able to clean 55 per cent or more plates than a \star -rated brand. Fat removal How well the liquid removes grease and keeps it dispersed and suspended in the water.

Value for money This takes into account the price quoted in the table and foam duration and fat removal ratings.

The Marks & Spencer Classic variety is slightly more expensive than its sister liquid, M&S Citrus (see left), but still offers good value for money and

it should be able to clean around 9,180 plates. It's particularly good at cleaning greasy dishes. We

found that one squirt cleans eight more fatty plates than the same amount of Persil's Aloe Vera liquid, which costs only a penny less.

while it doesn't quite match the best of our Best Buys, it offers good all-round cleaning and tackles greasy plates effectively - we estimate one bottle could clean 8,875 plates.
