This is our cheapest Best Buy tumble dryer. It dries quickly and evenly, and is quiet and easy to use. It's quite basic – it has no sensor, end-of-program buzzer or program-stage lights – but it showed no weaknesses in our tests and left clothes less creased than our other Best Buys.

Bosch dishwashers have a better than average reliability record. This full-sized free-standing model excels at cleaning crockery, cutlery and glassware, whether you're using the main or eco program. A 30-minute quick wash option is available if you're in a hurry.

This Best Buy Panasonic is very good at heating a single portion of food, and its defrosting options work well. It has a good range of functions, including a turbo reheat mode with extra power for liquidy foods. Some may find the controls a little cluttered.

Frigidaire's FRC150FF is petite but perfectly formed, and it works very well. It's frost-free, which will save you from the chore of defrosting. The fridge compartment cools evenly, so your food will be kept cold no matter where you place it, and food freezes quite quickly in the freezer.
