CLARIFICATIONS AND CORRECTIONS

Misuse of power Apr 07, p26

A solicitor's advice isn't essential when drawing up an EPA (see 'Checklist', p27). Many will writers and some independent financial advisers (IFAs) perform this service and you can also do it yourself with forms from a legal stationer. Solicitors, however, are covered by

indemnity insurance and an established complaints procedure if anything goes wrong. IFAs are not covered by FSA regulations for non-financial advice, such as on EPAs, and will writing is an unregulated profession, although some will writers may have indemnity insurance. However, as EPAs are powerful, and

often complex, documents, we recommend you take legal advice. See *Which?*, February 2007, p26, for more about making a will.
